C. Diagnosis: Stage 0 melanoma (in situ)

Dear readers,

The following are questions to ask when visiting a doctor if you have been diagnosed with stage 0 melanoma.

- 1. What is the difference between an in situ melanoma and an invasive melanoma?
- 2. Did the biopsy remove all the melanoma, or will I need another biopsy?
- 3. Does the treating surgeon have experience with melanoma patients if I need extensive excision of the melanoma?
- 4. Do you think that a second opinion regarding the biopsy needs to be sought to confirm the diagnosis before starting treatment?
- 5. Are there options other than surgery that would be suitable for treatment?
- 6. What is the probability that the melanoma has already spread to other parts of my body?
- 7. Will I need additional diagnostics to confirm the stage of melanoma?
- 8. What treatment plan do you suggest and why?
- 9. What is my prognosis if I follow this plan?
- 10. What kind of follow-up care will I need?
- 11. What is the probability that the cancer will reappear?

- 15. What preventive measures can I take to reduce the risk of second melanoma?
