Diagnosis: stage I melanoma

Dear readers,

The following are questions to ask when visiting a doctor if Ihave been diagnosed with first-stage melanoma.

- 1. What criteria led to the diagnosis of stage I?
- 2. Did the biopsy remove all the melanoma, or will I need another biopsy?
- 3. Do you think that a second opinion regarding the biopsy needs to be sought to confirm the diagnosis before starting treatment?
- 4. Is a sentinel lymph node biopsy necessary?
- 5. How much experience does the surgeon in charge have with a sentinel lymph node biopsy, if I need it?
- 6. Do you recommend getting a second opinion on this?
- 7. Are there options other than surgery that would be suitable for treatment?
- 8. After the current stage of melanoma, what is the probability that it has already spread to other parts of my body?
- 9. Will I need additional diagnostics to confirm the stage of melanoma; will you arrange for tumor marker analysis?
- 10. Which treatment plan (e.g. adjuvant chemotherapy) do you suggest and why?
- 11. What is my prognosis if I follow this plan?
- 12. What kind of follow-up care will I need?
- 13. What is the probability that the cancer will reappear?
- 14. How do you assess the possibility that a second melanoma could develop?
- 15. General questions for stage I
- 16. Have you inspected all moles and assessed my lymph nodes?
- 17. How often should I attend skin cancer screenings?
- 18. What preventive measures can I take to reduce the risk of second melanoma?
- 19. How do you assess the risk that other family members will also develop melanoma?
